#### **The Relationships of Unemployed During the Period of Unemployment**

The author gives a deep analysis of the social relationships of the unemployed in a less developed region of the country. She points out the difficulties the unemployed must face during the hard period, while they spend most of their time far away from the relatively safe background of a workplace. The study is a nice example of showing the personal world of these people with based on a sociological research, containing not only sociological implications of the phenomenon of unemployment in Hungary, but also giving a picture about their critical psychological situation.
